TO: Students Living in IUPUI Campus Housing during 2007-08 Academic Year

Starting in the Fall 2007, IUPUI Health Services is requiring all students living in IUPUI Campus Housing to provide documentation of vaccination or immunity to the following diseases:

- Measles
- Mumps
- Rubella (German Measles)

Accordingly, IUPUI Health Services requests completion of the questions below. We request you provide written documentation of your vaccinations / immunity. Documentation can be provided in any of the following forms:

- Copy of shot records documenting the measles, mumps, and rubella vaccinations.
- Copy of medical records documenting measles, mumps, and rubella vaccinations.
- Signed letter from physician attesting measles, mumps, and rubella vaccinations were received.
- Documentation of antibody titers showing immunity to measles, mumps, and rubella.
- For individuals graduating from an Indiana high school, a copy of Indiana high school diploma is sufficient. The diploma is acceptable documentation given Indiana requires such immunizations for students 13 years of age or older.

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On what dates did you receive the rubella (German measles) vaccine?
